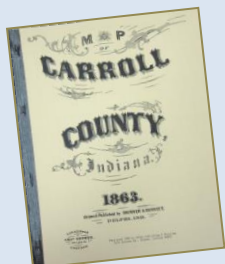

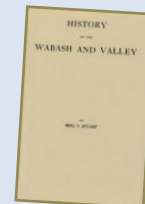

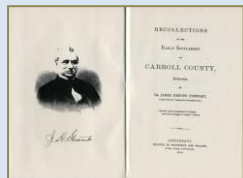

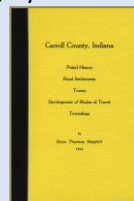

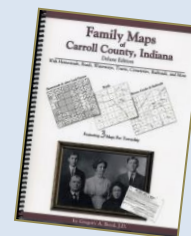

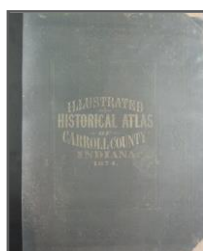

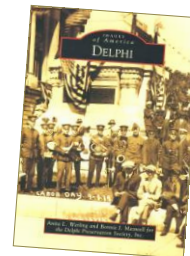

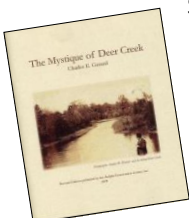

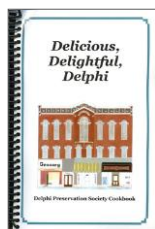

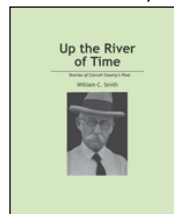

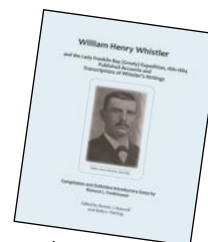

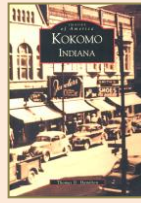

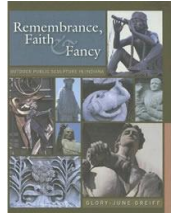

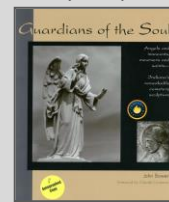

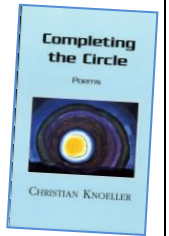

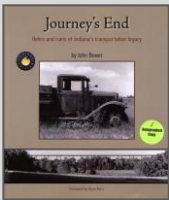
Guardians of the Soul—Angels and innocents, mourners and saints—Indiana’s remarkable cemetery sculpture

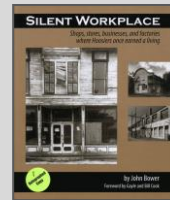
Journey’s End—Relics and ruins of Indiana’s transportation legacy. Has a photo of the Delphi interurban office and the sign detail from the Flora depot.



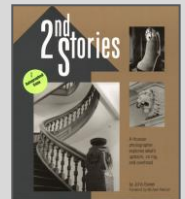
Lingering Spirit—A photographic tribute to Indiana’s fading, forlorn, and forgotten places

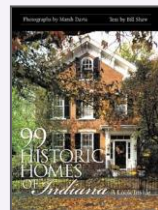

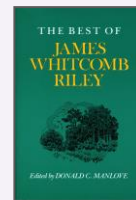

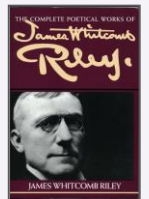
